## **When is TPS Graduation?**

Evening of Friday, June 6, 2025

## **Who is eligible to participate in TPS Graduation?**

TPS students who will complete their high school coursework by June 6, 2025. Graduating students must have taken at least two classes with TPS within the past two years.

## **Where will TPS Graduation take place?**

This graduation event will be offered in conjunction with TPS Summer Camp, which is held at Miracle Mountain Ranch, located in Spring Creek, PA.

## **Do students have to participate in TPS Summer Camp to graduate?**

Yes, any students wishing to participate in TPS Graduation must attend TPS Summer Camp. The week preceding graduation is a great chance to get to know the rest of your graduating class and have a “final hurrah” before heading to college, career, or whatever the future holds for you.



## **Is there any additional cost to attend the graduation?**

There is no additional cost for family and friends of the graduates to attend the graduation ceremony and reception. However, we do need you to RSVP for guests not already registered for TPS Summer Camp. There is a nominal fee for guests (i.e., those who are not already participating in the camp) who want to eat dinner in the camp cafeteria before the graduation. A survey will be later for each graduate to indicate how many friends and families will be attending graduation and pay the fees ahead of time. ## **How much does it cost?**

The cost of participation in TPS Graduation is \$100 per graduate. This is additional to a student's camp cost and a fraction of the actual cost because TPS pays for the graduation event. However, if this cost is still out of your reach and you would like to participate, please let us know.

TPS Summer Camp is open to students, alumni, siblings, parents, and friends – please see the TPS Summer Camp information for more details. For family and friends who wish to attend the graduation as a guest without attending TPS Summer Camp, there is local lodging available within reasonable driving distance of MMR. # What is included as part of the graduation event?

No need to worry about anything – we’ve got it all taken care of! We have tried to make this event as turnkey for you as possible, so you can focus on enjoying the event. We will take care of:

**Ceremony.** No need to worry about the decorations, speakers or order-of-events – TPS takes care of all of that! The speaker will usually be a TPS teacher, the MC will usually be one of the TPS staff, and one or more of the graduates will be chosen to represent the graduating class in an address to the parents.

**Reception.** Hosted reception with decorations, cake and punch.

**Cap, gown (rental), tassel and honor cords.** Royal blue mortarboard cap and graduation gown with dated tassel provided for all graduates. Traditional color-coded “honor cords” signifying various accomplishments will be provided by TPS. During the ceremony, only the honor cords provided by TPS may be worn – no other regalia (e.g., Boy Scouts, JROTC, sports medals). However, other individual regalia may be displayed on the grad’s individual display table and may be worn for some of the photos in the individual grad and family photo sessions, if desired.

**Event Program.** Attractively designed and digitally provided for graduates and their attendees.

**Photography.** Professional-quality photos taken by MMR photo team prior to and during the ceremony. Additional photo sessions are available for families who wish to have a family portrait with the graduate. After editing, photos will be available (individual or the entire package) by download for a small fee (typically around \$10 for the package).

**“About Me” Board Showcase.** All graduates will be asked to create a display board with pictures and information about themselves, their schooling years, and their plans for college and the future. The pictures and personal memorabilia for this activity should be gathered and planned out by each participant prior to camp, as there will be time only to assemble and glue the “About Me” board during the graduates-only activities at the camp. These boards will be on display at the reception.

**Digital Photo Slideshow.** All graduates will be asked to submit a specified number of photos commemorating their childhood and high school years for inclusion in the photo slideshow.

**TPS “Class of 2025” T-Shirt.** Something to remember your graduation (and get all your friends to sign)!





## **Will TPS provide diplomas for the students?**

Each graduate's parents certify the completion of the high school education, so it will be up to each graduate's parents to provide the diploma or other commemoration of their student's achievement and bring it to the graduation ceremony. If your student is a part of the TPS Diploma Program, then TPS will also provide or present your TPS diploma.



## Graduate-Only Events (during TPS Summer Camp week)

### Wednesday evening:

A fun night for the graduates to spend time together, enjoy some snacks, decorate their caps, and assemble their pre-planned “About Me” boards.



### Thursday evening:

Graduation ceremony rehearsal.



### Friday afternoon:

Photo session for each graduate and family, brief ceremony rehearsal with parents, and dinner.
